Comments I arrived at the property and met the owner who granted me access.

As I walked into the area where the slaughtering took place, I observed the sheep being slaughtered in front of the others which was already slaughtered. The blood was still on the floor and was not cleaned after each animal. I addressed this and told them they cannot continue if this is not rectified. They rectified it immediately.

The animals were handled in humanely. They were dragged by their legs, ears and fleece. I addressed this and it was rectified immediately.

While still monitoring the slaughter, it started raining heavily. The cattle and sheep was standing in the rain. I told the owner to move the cattle to the shed so that they could be protected from the heavy weather. This was rectified immediately.

I issued a warning (Warning 14704) addressing all the concerns, even though they had been rectified immediately before I left the property.
