Comments We arrived at the property and informed the owner of our presence . He granted access and we monitored the selling of animals as well as the slaughtering where it was done.

The only concern we had was with the loading of tbe cattle as they did not have a ramp at all and wanted tbe cattle to jump onto the truck/ trailer. This was stopped and they were instructed to get a ramp before they were allowed to load the animals. This was rectified and a ramp had been secured. The animals were loaded safely and humanely as per the SANS codes.

The owner was also very rude to Inspector Ngcofe. The situation was refused bu the SPCA staff and no further incidents were had.

The monitoring to take place the next day as they will be continuing on Sunday.
