3. Farm Activity:

4. Transportation Concerns:

The farm avoids involvement in the transportation of animals.

When inspectors stop clients from using unsuitable transport, the farm questions it.

Their focus appears to be mainly on sales, and they seem unwilling to address issues related to animal transport.

5. Inspector's Instructions:

Inspector Ayanda requested that the two goats be slaughtered yesterday .

The farm delayed the process, playing what appeared to be a stalling tactic.

6. Operating Hours:

The farm was supposed to close at 1:00 PM.

They changed their decision and remained open.

7. Animal Feeding Practice:

Feeding is done regularly both before and after animals are inspected.
