108 animals were sold today.

2. Goat Issues:

2 goats were slaughtered:

One had a skin condition; the body was buried.

The other was limping.

3. Farm Activity:

The farm was very busy with sales.

4. Transportation Concerns:

The farm avoids involvement in the transportation of animals.

When inspectors stop clients from using unsuitable transport, the farm questions it.

Their focus appears to be mainly on sales, and they seem unwilling to address issues related to animal transport.

5. Inspector's Instructions:

Inspector Ayanda requested that the two goats be slaughtered yesterday .

The farm delayed the process, playing what appeared to be a stalling tactic.
