Comments Upon inspection 9 cattle was seen on the property of which of them appear to be underweight, 2 cows appeared to have serious leg injuries as the injuries appear to have maggots inside, no water or shelter was available and the living environment is full of hazardous materials, we emergency slaughtered the 2 injured cows and instructed the owners not to slaughter the others as they don't have a facility or any equipment to slaughter cattle, I can confirm the cattle was still at the property this evening and will possibly be taken to viljoen farm to slaughter as they have a crush. A warning and a fine was issued to the owner.
