 Comments Another follow up was carried out at the facility. They were unsuccessful in obtaining a trailer so they decided to herd the animals to the other facility.

I requested that some of the other SPCA staff come to assist us as well and the majority of them were successfully moved to the other property.

One broke away from the herd into another property. He was severely stressed and we couldn't get him to leave. We decided that the most humane way to deal with this situation is to euthanize the bull on the property where he is. This had been done.

The other six will be slaughtered tomorrow at Al Musaaaid. We will have someone monitor the slaughtering of those animals.
