Comments I had quite a few issues here. There was not adequate shelter for the sheep. I found one sheep that couldnt walk, and one with blood coming from the back. Some sheep were emaciated so I asked the guys to give them additional food.
The handlers dragged sheep so I had to show them how to carry the sheep. One knife was blunt and the slaughterer struggled to cut. There was a black dog with matted fur and two Rottweilers that were on static chains without water and chains around their necks. The one rottweiler did not have shelter.
