Comments I arrived at the facility and was met with some hostility. The owner, Uthmaan, was very arrogant and told me that no official is allowed on the property without him being present . He then said that if we want, we can obtain a court order. I refused the situation and he granted me access.

The sheep was still closed within the tent and had not yet been fed. When questioned, I was told that the feed is on its way from Philippi (Schaapkraal). It had arrived that it was given to the animals prior to me leaving the property.

No concerns were observed in terms of the slaughtering and the slaughterers appeared quite competent. This was the last day of slaughtering and no slaughtering will take place tomorrow. All animals will be removed from the premises. This matter to be considered closed.
