Then also observed the bull slaughtering, there was no hustle to get the bull into the tilting crush, the problem started after the bull was into the crush, where the crush appeared to be not proper as the foot of the bull came out of the crush. The owner owner of the farm allowed the owner of the cow to slaughter, the customer was not fit to slaughter, the guy who is assisting the farmer had to intervened by continuing to cut the bull. I had to issue a warning as follows. Your facility lacks the proper infrastructure to humanely restrain cattle . You are therefore not permitted to slaughter cattle. A tilting crush is required for humane restraint. Tethering is not allowed under any circumstances. You must either make use of a compliant facility or install a suitable tilting crush. Failure to comply may result in legal action, including seizure of animals, arrest, or prosecution for animal cruelty. I made it clear to the owner that, I will have to stun the cattles if the crush is proper, he agreed. And to Refrain from allowing people that doesn't know on how to cut the animals as that caused unnecessary suffering to the animals
