1. You are herewith directed to comply with the lawful instructions issued by the undersigned authorized officer as set out in this notice. These instructions are in accordance with Section 36 of the Animal Keeping By-Law, 2021 in respect of the animal/s identified above.
2. You are directed to ensure compliance within seven (7) calendar days by taking the following steps to abate such nuisance or contravention:

Keep animal that creates a nuisance from the manner or conditions under which the animal is kept (1st offence)

3. You may, within seven calendar days from the date of receipt of this notice, make representations, in writing, to the Deputy Chief: Animal Control Unit, Law Enforcement Services in respect of this notice (Fax no. 086 201 1451)
4. You are herewith also given notice that your animal/s may be seized and impounded in terms of Section 20 of the Animal Keeping By-Law, 2021 if the steps identified in this notice and/or necessary to abate such nuisance or contravention have not been effected.
5. Furthermore, non-compliance with this notice is a criminal offence in terms of Section 35 of the Animal By-Law, 2021 and this may therefore be referred for prosecution.

**NB: A Peace Officer may, without a warrant, arrest any person who willfully obstructs him in the execution of his duty—Criminal Procedure Act 51 of 1977, Section 40(1)(j)**
