Dear SPCA Officer

I hope you're well.

I'm writing to formally request confirmation from your office regarding the surrender of four dogs currently located at 6 Imhoff Street, Monte Vista, Cape Town — three of which are English Bulldogs.

Background Summary:

These dogs were brought to the property after an arrangement between myself and their owner, Mr. Jacques Frylinck, who was residing in the United States at the time. While I did obtain my mother's verbal consent for the dogs to be temporarily housed here, it is important to note that the property belongs to my grandmother, and we are all tenants — including my mother.

All responsibilities from the outset — including transport, setup, safety installations, quoting, bookings, purchasing, and collection — were managed by me personally. Mr. Frylinck paid me to coordinate these tasks, and I completed them using my own vehicle and resources.

Although my son Jeanté assisted with daily upkeep such as feeding and cleaning after the dogs, this was only part of the care arrangement. I handled the installation of covers, kennels, pool-shielding, bookings, quotes, and pickup logistics.

13/10/2024 – Shiona: “Hi moet ons die honde gaan op tel? En hoelaat?”

29/09/2024 – Jacques: “Pool deposit paid. Sent POP to email.”

11/10/2024 – Shiona: “Die pool cover kom tussen 2 en 3.”

11/10/2024 – Shiona: “Die hokke is hier. Ek moet nou dat Jeante ry om geld te trek...”

12/11/2024 – Shiona: “Roxy rug stukkend.”

15/11/2024 – Jacques: “PTT voice note about issues with dogs fighting.”

03/11/2024 – Shiona: “Roxy se een oog is terug na normaal.”

09/11/2024 – Shiona: “Roxy is soos 'n flippen baba... elke aand krap sy tot sy inkom.”

Surrender History:

On 2 July 2025, two of the four dogs were surrendered to your care. This was done with the verbal go-ahead from their father, Mr. Frylinck. I was advised at the time that, under the circumstances and given that the dogs were left here with us, I have the right to proceed with the surrender of the remaining dogs as well.

I would like to state the attending spca officer as given me verbal confirmation I have the legal right to surrender the remaining dogs.

Request:

I now wish to proceed with the surrender of all four dogs and am formally requesting:

1. Written confirmation that I may legally proceed based on the above; and
2. The relevant handover documentation to complete the process.

Attached is the written notice I previously sent to Mr. Frylinck, which has gone unanswered. I simply want to ensure all actions are handled lawfully and transparently. I can provide additional documentation of our planning and expenses if required.

Please note that my objective is to ensure the animals are safely and humanely taken in, while also protecting myself and my children from further manipulation and emotional distress.

I would also assurance that my son (Jeante), who was involved in assisting purely as a family member, will not be held liable for the surrender process.

I truly appreciate your time and hope to receive confirmation from your office as soon as possible .
