Comments:	Upon arrival, we were met by Tashwin's uncle, Mr. Shafiek, and Tashwin's mother. We were informed that Tashwin was not available as he had been stabbed nine times during the course of the previous week. Mr. Shafiek granted us access to the property to inspect for any remaining animals. During the inspection, we observed one adult pitbull, tan and white in colour, confined to a section next to a bungalow. At the time of inspection, no food or water was visible. Instructions were immediately given to ensure the animal had access to clean drinking water and food without delay. Mr. Shafiek was educated on the City of Cape Town Animal Keeping By-law, specifically regarding the maintenance of hygienic living conditions for animals and the consequences of non-compliance, which may include fines. We advised that a follow-up inspection will be conducted within 7 days to assess compliance and improvements to the living conditions. It is noted that the other dogs previously kept on the property were surrendered to the SPCA under admission numbers G44885 and G44886.
