I met with one of the owners manyawuza and she informed me that other farmers are not available as they are at work. I informed her of the concerns that was brought to our attention and she said that they are trying their best with this matter and camps that are wet they rotated the cows.

I explained to her that if you own any animals under your control to always ensure that the animals have the following needs;

1. The animal have access to adequate shelter against the elements such as sun, wind and rain
2. Ensure that the animals have access to clean living environment e.g no obstructions laying around that could potentially cause injuries such as poles, wires
3. Ensure that the animal have access to drinkable water at all times while in the camps
4. Ensure that the animals have access to adequate food that provides the proper nutrients such as Otay, straw and hay

I called the supervisor and informed him that we can try education first here at this farm with help of the education officer thembi and he agreed. I called thembi and asked to meet and discuss the matter regarding a joint education program for the farmers and see what we can help them with in this regard maybe water and feed in the meantime.

We will meet on Monday to dicuss a way forward with him
