Comments:	Upon arrival, we met with Ms Lettie Diedericks, who granted us access to her property. During the inspection, we observed four dogs on the premises. All dogs had access to adequate shelter, food, and water. However, two of the dogs were found to be chained. When queried, Ms Diedericks explained that these two dogs are aggressive and tend to run out and attack people if not restrained. Ms Diedericks was educated on the appropriate use of running chains and provided with the relevant informational leaflet. She further advised that she is no longer able to cope with the care of her two crossbreed dogs and expressed her intention to surrender them. Ms Diedericks mentioned that her brother-in-law was supposed to assist her due to her age, but he has not come as agreed. A final compliance notice was issued, instructing her to clean and maintain the living space for the remaining dogs. The matter has been referred to Maggie to arrange for a collection officer to collect the two surrendered dogs.
