Please review the email below and advise if this is a matter we need to investigate further or if it can be referred to L.E.

We have contacted the owner of Bruno, as we received a report from Jessica stating that Bruno was attacked by the dogs in question while chained inside the property. According to the owner, who was not present during the incident, his children (a daughter and son, both under 14 years old) were present and informed him that the owner of the four dogs was walking them in the street without leashes. Bruno, who was not chained, managed to escape through an opening in the fence and attacked one of the four dogs. During this encounter, the owner of the four dogs, along with three men, encouraged his other three dogs to further attack Bruno.

We currently have no evidence to suggest that there was any intent to incite the attack. Both owners appear to share fault in this incident, as Bruno initiated the attack on one of the other dogs. Additionally, during our conversation, Bruno's owner mentioned that there is a tuck shop on the corner with cameras, but the shop owner is refusing to provide the footage. The shop owner has requested that the SPCA obtain the footage, as many community members are afraid of him due to his frequent run-ins with the law. We have requested photo's of Bruno after the attack.

1. Lexi, 3 June (078 544 5700) suspect walked his dogs past the victims house; dog was attacked late at night and even though she was taken to TAH a/h, she passed away due to extensive injuries.
2. Chezy, May (071 4852 350) - suspect brought his 4 dogs onto this property while the victim was on a chain; the dog is now mainly kept inside due to the owners' fear of their dog being attacked again.
3. Bruno, 21 July (063 485 8230) - dog was chained in his yard but could see through a small gate; suspect set one dog on him but once he realized that Bruno was fighting back, he set the remaining 3 on him too.
