Comments:	I called the number on the case and spoke to Lydia Mokoena who said she was the actual owner of the black female dog named Katarina. She said she had the dog since 2016 and she got it from a friend. I then asked why she placed the dog on a chain and she said the dog had a rope around the neck and a chain attached to it. Thew reason for this, according to the owner, was to ensure tha the dog does not run away becasse she was aggressive. According to me, the dog was not aggressive because I handled the dog when it was offloaded at the SPCA - the dog was very friendly. Lydia further stated that the dog was chaind / tethered 3 weeks before we collected it (which means it was chained / tethered since early July) and when she noticed that it was not barking on 16 July, she asked her son to check on the dog and that is when they noticed the dog has a wound on the neck. I iwll relay this information to the Chief on Friday and see the validity of a cruelty case.
