Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Davids introduced ourselves and explained that we are going door-to-door conducting routine inspections. The owner Mrs. Kathleen Schreuder allowed us to gain access.

Upon entering the house, we observed a Tabby female cat named Roxy that appeared to be in a good condition. The owner has a Wendy house with no yard, the cat has access to the Wendy house and sleeps inside with the owner as well. the living environment was clean and there appeared to be adequate space available as well, however there was no water available. The owner said that she does

give the cat water in the morning, we explained that she needs to check throughout the day to ensure the cat has access to water at all times. Before we left, we ensured that the cat was given water. The owner showed us the food that she uses to feed the cat and the pallets she uses as well.

A warning was issued by Inspector Davids to:

1. ensure water is available at all times.

The owner signed and accepted the warning. A follow-up inspection will be conducted to check if the owner is compliant in terms of the warning that has been issued.

Legislation:

Section 2(1)(c) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 for unnecessarily denying water to the cat kept on the property.
