FINDINGS

Confinement of animal/s: Free roaming - in property
Adequate space: Yes

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Davids introduced ourselves and explained that we are going door-to-door conducting routine inspections. The Owner Ms. Vanessa Quinton then allowed us onto the property.

upon entering the property, we observed a tan adult dog named Hondtjie and a cat named Katjie. The property appeared to be of an adequate space, the living environment appeared to be clean as well but there was no shelter for the dog and the cat sleeps inside the house.

There was no water available, the owner said that she did not know that there was no water available. We informed her that there should always be water available and as the owner she should ensure to check throughout the day.

both the cat and the dog appear to be in a fit and healthy state and no veterinary concerns were observed during the inspection.

A warning was issued by Inspector Davids to:

1. Get adequate shelter within 7 days to protect from weather conditions.
2. Ensure there is water available at all times.

The owner signed and accepted the warning. A follow-up inspection will be conducted to check if the owner is compliant in terms of the warning that has been issued.

Legislation:

Section 2(1)(b) & (c) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 for failing to provide the dog with adequate shelter to protect from weather conditions and failing to ensure there is potable water available to the animals on the property at all times.
