FINDINGS

Upon arrival, Inspector David's and I introduced ourselves to the worker and informed her that we would like to conduct a pro-active inspection of the chicken hawking site and she allowed us to do so.

We observed 17 chickens at the hawking site, there was no overcrowding observed at the time of the inspection, there was water available, but the water was dirty. The living environment appeared to be reasonably clean and no excessive faeces build up. I checked the chickens and did not observe any veterinary concerns regarding the chickens.

While conducting the inspection, I observed the worker tie up one chicken that had been sold. I immediately stopped the worker and made her untie the chicken's legs and told her that at no time is she allowed to tie the chicken's legs. We also observed that there were multiple protruding wires on the cage that may injure the chickens and we instructed the worker to rectify the concern within the given time frame.

Inspector David's Issued a warning to:

1. Refrain from tying the chickens by the legs.
2. Ensure water is clean at all times.
3. Fix/remove protruding wire within 7 days.
