FINDINGS

Confinement of animal/s: Free roaming - property not adequately fenced
Adequate space: Yes
Clean living environment: Yes
Water available: No ***
Adequate shelter available: No ***
Animal/s in good condition: Yes

Upon arrival at the next property, the owner Ms. Katy Juries came was home and we explained who we are and that we are conducting door-to-door inspections and would like to examine the animals kept on the property and the environment they are so kept. the owner allowed access.

We observed 2 Brindle female dogs named Girly and Klentjie, The owner informed us that she also has two DSH females Snowy (white/tan) and Kat (tortie/white) but she was unsure of "Kats" whereabouts as she did not want the cat anymore. We searched the immediate area but we could not locate the cat and told the owner upon follow up we will take the cat but she must confine it to the house until we return.

The two xbreed brindle dogs appeared to be in good condition, there was adequate space as the property was not enclosed, there however was no water available or shelter. We explained that the dogs require shelter to protect from weather conditions even if it appears as though they do not use them. We then examined the cat which was seen eating food and also had water available inside the house which is where the cats also sleep.

A warning was issued by Inspector Davids to:

1. Get adequate shelter within 7 days to protect from weather conditions.
2. Ensure that water is available at all times
