While conducting other follow-ups in the informal settlement, the Owner Mrs. Katy Juries called us over to her property. Once we had concluded the other inspection we proceeded to Mrs. Juries house.

Once Inspector Davids and I had arrived, the owner informed us that she had managed to confine the cat she would like to surrender over to the SPCA. However, I noticed that her one Brindle and White dog named Kleintjie was limping. I examined her paw to feel for thorns but did not find any. We informed the owner that they dog will have to be taken to a veterinary clinic so that they can examine her and diagnose the cause of the limp.

The owner said she would not be able to afford veterinary costs and we educated the owner in terms of Section 2(1)(e) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 about the responsibility an owner has in relation to veterinary concerns. The owner understood and chose to rather surrender the dog as well to prevent any further unnecessary suffering. The owner signed the cat and dog over to the SPCA.

Inspector Davids issued a warning stating that:

1. Whenever your animals appear to be sick/injured, you must take them to a veterinary clinic without delay

A follow-up will be done on the property to ensure compliance regarding shelter for the remaining dog.
