Comments: At approximately 14h23, I have returned the call of a guy who introduced himself as Kyle Jonas with cellphone No 081 441 1951.

He told me that the dog called Tupac belongs to his wife and his children, however they do not reside at the property during the week, they live with him in Ravensmead, Kyle told me that, his wife or his children, they always go to the property to clean, to give the dog water and to feed the dog.

Kyle told me that, he is feeding the dog with Kutta dog food, which is something that i don't believe. He mentioned that, he changed into Kutta dog food recently, he also mentioned that, might be the reason why the dog is underweight.

He mentioned that, he has a problem with the other people who are residing in that area as they called the SPCA for no reason, I made hom to understand that, who ever called the SPCA had a reason as we also found the concerns on the dog.

Kyle was not happy about the warnings that were issued to him to provide the dog with proper and adequate shelter against the elements, he claimed that the sleep under the veranda, he also mentioned that the AACL inspector said, the veranda was adequate against the elements.

I explained to him that, the veranda might be adequate against the rain and the sun, however, it might be adequate against the cold. Then he said, we need to give him until the month end to purchase a shelter, I told him that, we give people 7 days to provide the shelter, 18 days is too long, then he said, the SPCA will have to give him the money to purchase the shelter, I have explained to him that, there is no law that forces people to own animals, it is our choice, therefore we need to do what is best for the animals.

Then he said, he will try to get a shelter over the weekend and he will increase the amount of food that he is giving to the dog, he also mentioned that the living environment is now cleaned, i told him to wooden stump, the spades and the other hazardous materials where the dog is being kept, he agreed.

He said, he will send the pictures of the shelter as soon as he dropped off and he will send us the pictures of the food each and everytime time he feeds the dog.

I think we need to do a follow-up inspection on the shelter as well as on the condition of the dog next week monday.
