Comments: called janeth back after junaid has called in inwhich her main concern is the dogs attacking the animals which i explained she will have to call l.e for assistance which she stated that she has called l.e on wednesday when the attack happened and l.e was at the premises, the owners were home but didnt open up and the officer left, i explained to her that she needs to get an affidavit stating what happened and as junaid mentioned in the call prior to this call that the owner of the dogs brought a cat to her in a cage which she thought was strange, i asked her if she knows where the cat came from and she said apparently some organisation but he apparently gave the cat back. junaid asked spca to do a welfare check at the property and check for the cat which i stated he wouldnt have any longer but on the call with the compl janeth who stated that he took the cat back because she didnt want it and shes not bothered with the cat as she is worried the dogs will actually attack a child or person. She even mentioned that the owners rceived a fine and other notices but nothing is being done about the dogs roaming, she further mentioned there is one black dog that is named whitey that to her appears underweight and the other 3 dogs are fine and as long as the owners are living there she has never physically seen a food bowl but has never been inside the property as she doesnt know if the dogs have shelter either. i advised her that we will do a welfare check at the porperty on the dogs in question as she has mentioned that the dogs only have one small water bowl, no food was seen and one dog appeared undereight. inwhich i stated if no contraventions of the APA are observed the case will be closed and she then replied no, the case will not be closed so i explained again that the roaming of animals outside the premises is an infridgement of the animal keeping bylaws which spca has no powers to enforce and she will have to contact the acu which she then said shes going to speak openly and she stated that the "black foreigners" came to live there and just dont care about the dogs as they put the dogs outside in the morning and in the evening, she apologised for using the terminaoogy above and said shes not racist but these "black foreigners" must be dealt with. the complainant in question is an elderly pentioner who doesnt seem to understand what i was trying to convey that she needed to call the acu regarding her concerns and spca will check on the welfare concerns of the dogs seen at the property.
