Comments: I took a walk through the community, which consists of around 6 properties. All the houses had dogs but in total they about approximately 10 animals in total. A few of the dogs looked underweight but not to the level of being emaciated. Speaking to some of the residents, the main concern for the area is deworming and tick/flea treatment. They requested food for the animals as well, as majority of the animals eat house food. The animals are all free roaming, access to shelter and water. One dog was on a chain, but it was put on the chain because I came into the property. I advised that resident to set up a running chain for these instances, and I will check up when I return. I believe we can do a small outreach here, and bring deworm and tick/flea treatment. If possible, a few bags of food would help as well. There were also some residents keen on sterilizations and maybe surrenders. Also, apparently there are more houses on the other side of the hill but the one resident told me that its not accessible by vehicle really and the people are mostly at work currently. They said in total Im looking at around 20 animals for the area in total. I took the one residents details and advised i will be in contact with her to arrange when i will return and she will spread the word. I think 2-3 vehicles would be sufficient, with at least one trailer. Basic deworm, tick/flea treatment and food would be needed.
