Subject: Urgent Animal Welfare Concern – Request for Investigation

Dear NSPCA Team,

My name is Kai Parsons, and I am writing to urgently request your assistance regarding serious animal welfare concerns at my current residence:

I am deeply concerned for the well-being of several animals in my family's care:

1. Tauriel – Weimaraner
 - o Some time ago, I personally witnessed Tauriel being sexually abused by my father, Bradley Parsons.
 - o At the time, both he and Tauriel developed sores and rashes, which later disappeared after my father applied topical creams.
 - o I am devastated that this occurred and feel Tauriel is still at risk.
2. Nym – German Shepherd
 - o She has multiple sores and tumours across her body.
 - o I have repeatedly asked my family to take her to a veterinarian, but they have refused, despite having the financial means.
 - o Instead, my father—who is a pharmacist, not a veterinarian—has been medicating her with Tramadol without proper veterinary oversight.
3. Miyuki – Cat
 - o She is confined upstairs in a room where, in summer, temperatures exceed 35°C.
 - o She is only occasionally let out.

Additionally:

- I am the only one who reliably fills the dogs' water bowls. Without my intervention, they are often left without water.
- My family members—Madeleine Acton (mother), Elbereth Parsons (sister), and Bradley Parsons (father)—have all failed to ensure the animals' welfare, despite having the resources to do so.
- The animals legally belong to my family, not me, which complicates my ability to take independent action.
- I currently do not have a driver's license as my parents have taken it from me, which prevents me from transporting the animals to a veterinarian myself.

I am preparing to leave this household due to the abusive environment, but I cannot move forward knowing these animals remain in danger. I am requesting that the NSPCA urgently investigate and, if necessary, intervene to ensure the safety and proper care of Tauriel, Nym, and Miyuki.

I would also like to formally lay a charge of animal neglect against all the above-mentioned family members for their role in allowing this suffering to continue.

Thank you for your time and for the essential work you do. Please let me know if you require any further details or a formal statement.
