Comments: Dear Kai,

We would like to thank you for reporting your concerns and for allowing us the opportunity to investigate the matter.

Our Inspector visited the property and was granted access by your father, Mr. Bradley. Each of the animals was individually examined, and no signs of sexual abuse were observed. There were no indications of swelling, discharge, or injuries to their private areas. All the animals were found to be in fair condition, with clean living environments, shelter, and access to water. We also confirmed that the dogs are housed inside the residence.

Your father informed our Inspector about the situation regarding your court appearance and asked that we speak with you directly about the allegations. When you arrived, you stated that you had no physical proof but believed that your father may have put peanut butter on the dogs' genitals. We must advise that such allegations are extremely serious and can only be pursued further if substantiated with credible evidence. At this stage, there is no physical evidence to support the allegations.

During the visit, concerns were raised about the German Shepherd's hind legs. Your father provided veterinary medication prescribed for the condition, which he manages daily. He is a pharmacist and your mother is a medical doctor. Upon further inspection, what was thought to be "lumps" appeared to be the dog shedding its winter coat. The dog showed no signs of pain or distress.

Additionally, the Yorkie in question is of advanced age, and based on its condition, we were advised that it is not suitable for sterilisation due to health risks.

Based on our findings, we did not observe any contraventions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, and the matter will now be considered finalised. No further action will be taken at this stage.
