FINDINGS

Confinement of animal/s: Free roaming - in property
Adequate space: Yes

Upon arrival, Inspector Davids and I introduced ourselves and informed the owner that we are conducting door-to-door inspections in the area. The owner then granted us access to the property.

We observed a xbreed dog named Major (black/white) and a xbreed dog named Mason (tan/white) on the property. Both dogs appeared to be slightly underweight, there was a large plastic kennel located on the property that both dogs are able to use comfortably. There was adequate space for the dogs and there was water available but the living environment needed to be cleaned up and unnecessary objects removed.

I gave both the dogs dewormer and fibronil as the owner informed us that they have not received since last year.

The owner had informed us of a pitbull that had wounds in the genital area, however the dog was not home and the owner was unsure of where the dog was. We told the owner to keep the dog confined to the property and once we conduct the follow-up inspection we will have a look at the wounds.

Inspector Davids issued a warning to:

1. Ensure your dogs get adequate food on a daily basis.
2. Clean the living environment within 5 days.
