Comments:	I returned the call of Melani as she requested a call back from us. She explained that they feed the dog house food but I told her that is unfortunately not sufficient and that the dog needs quality , good food. Melani said it is a bit difficult for them to buy dog food etc but I told her they will have to comply with the warning as the dog could have underlying veterinary concerns as well, and she understood. Melani told me they normally get home between 4 and 4:30 pm so it could work if the inspector could come that time then they will be able to give him access to the property. Further to this, Melani said that the dog has a kennel but it is in front of the car and the inspector can't see it. Melani asked that we give her an extension on the warning until next week, 29 August, which I granted. I cautioned Melani by informing her that if they do not comply with the warning by the extension date then we might obtain a warrant to remove the dog or they have the option to surrender the dog to the SPCA. Melani said the dog belongs to her daughter. Melani thanked me for the extension and the information I gave her.
