Dear SPCA Team,

I hope this message finds you well.

I would like to bring to your attention a welfare concern I witnessed at the Sunrise Superette in Mowbray. Sunrise cafe. Yesterday, I saw three small goldfish bowls containing around seven or eight goldfish between them. The bowls are very small, with only an air pipe placed inside, and no proper filtration, plants, or enrichment for the fish.

On Sunday, I counted nine goldfish, but by yesterday there were only four remaining. This is extremely concerning, as it suggests that some of the fish have already died due to the inadequate conditions.

The goldfish are being kept in plain glass jars with minimal care, no stimulation, and insufficient living conditions. This is not acceptable, and I would be grateful if SPCA could please investigate, provide education to the establishment, and intervene to ensure the fish are given more appropriate care.
