Dear CHIEF INSPECTOR JACO and Cape of Good Hope SPCA Inspectorate,

I wish to urgently report a case of animal cruelty and neglect that requires immediate investigation. The individual concerned is breeding and keeping cats in unhygienic, overcrowded conditions and has committed acts of cruelty towards animals.

Details of Incidents

Overcrowding and Unhygienic Conditions

- She breeds cats inside a small home already occupied by two adults and four children (children ages 2, 7, 12 and 14).
- Currently, there are approximately eight cats inside, including one that is heavily pregnant. The cats are not confined to the premises.
- This situation poses health risks to both animals and humans.

Killing of Kittens

- She deliberately killed kittens born from a neighbour's cat by placing them in a plastic bag and throwing them into a rubbish bin.
- She stated she would not feed 'bastard kittens.'

Abandonment of a Neighbour's Cat

- She captured the neighbour's male cat (the one that impregnated her cat), wrapped it in a duvet, and abandoned it by the roadside in Atlantis.

Witnesses/Evidence:

I confronted her about these suspicions, and she admitted to killing the kittens and abandoning the neighbour's cat.

These actions appear to violate the Animals Protection Act and demonstrate a dangerous temperament towards animals. I believe the cats currently in her care may be at risk of further harm if no intervention takes place.

I request urgent investigation and intervention by the SPCA. Please confirm receipt of this report and advise on the next steps.
