Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with Mr Kurt Hardnick, owner of the dog on the property. We observed a medium X breed dog, fair body condition, chained on a short static chain with the raw chain around its's neck. There was a shelter but it is broken, and the water bucket was dirty and empty. The living area was also dirty. I asked the owner why the dog is on such a short chain and he said the dog bites through the fence and escapes the property. The dog is also very friendly and then strangers walk with the dog and use it for crime, that's why he has put the dog on a chain. I told him that he must then put the dog on a running chain, as the dog cannot live on such a short chain. The dog will also need a suitable collar should it be on the running chain. The shelter needs to be fixed as well, and the dog must have access to clean potable water at all times.

I issued a warning, 21812, to:

* Untie/unchain the animal immediately to roam freely inside the property or as a last resort place the animal on a running chain within 6 days.

* Provide the animal with sufficient potable water 24 hours a day.

* Provide the animal with adequate shelter against the elements within 6 days.

* Clean and hygienically maintain the animal's living environment within 6 days.

* Provide a suitable collar for the animal within 6 days

Myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele cosigned the warning, and Mr Kurt Hardnick signed and accepted the warning.
