On the 16th of September 2025, at approximately 19h30, I called Mrs Williams with ID number 8505131251084 to get more information about the dogs that were removed from her property. I asked Mrs Williams who the owners of the dogs were, and she said both her and her husband, Mr Marlin Williams were the owners of the dogs named Tiger (male, not sterilised, brown with black ears in colour, boerboel type dog) and Reeva (female, not sterilised, brown and white in colour, boerboel type dog) and that they bought both dogs several years back when the dogs were still puppies (young) from someone in Mitchells Plain and Greenville, Fisantekraal, respectively. Mrs Williams further stated that Reeva was approximately a year old when she died and Tiger is 6 years old.

I asked Mrs Williams what they fed the dogs, and she stated they bought dog food from Shoprite or Fisantekraal Animal Welfare when they could afford it. When they could not afford it, they cooked potato peels for the dog and gave it with porridge for the dogs. Mrs Williams said she noticed that Reeva was not doing well for about a month before she died but they did not take her to the veterinarian for assessment and / or treatment. Furthermore, Mrs Williams stated that she informed of Reeva's death either on the 6th or 7th of August. I believe she was informed on the 6th because the body of the dog was retrieved on that day, as per paragraph 3.
