I need to report a potential case of animal neglect. This afternoon, I was exiting the Newlands contour path, through the back of Kirstenbosch gardens, and came across a Border Collie looking incredibly malnourished, timid, and it had a broken leg that hadn't been cared for.

We spotted the dog next to some of the staff housing, lying right on the road. It's most definitely someone's dog, but it does not look cared for. The dog was really friendly and came right up to us. Looks like her leg has been broken for a while, as it seemed quite accustomed to functioning with the injury, but it definitely needs some sort of care.

I know you guys are struggling at the moment, and at full capacity, but is there any chance that this is something you can help with in some way, or if you could even point me in the direction of someone who can?
