The chain possibly weighs more than the dog. The dog has mange and is covered in old car oil. His body is riddled in open wounds which according to the owner is the rats biting him. The dog is also severely thin. Tin Can Town serves the community of Blikkiesdorp FREE of charge. We NEVER fail to show up for our monthly outreaches eventhough we are under resourced we make a plan for essential preventative treatments and over ectodex dip baths, bravecto for those with visible mange, diatomaceous earth to get parasites (internal and external) under control and to maintain a parasite free environment. Since we have been there for more than a decade, the community are very aware of where to find help. These owners seem very uninterested in our efforts to educate them and rather just want the problem (the dog) to disappear. I am attaching a pic for you to see the pitiful condition of this dog.
