Dear Greta.

We acknowledge receipt of your email.

Here are the fact and what we have evidence of.

On our initial inspection dated 31 December 2025, we did not find anyone at the property but a Warning was issued to the owner / caretaker of the dog, based on the evidence we had, to provide the dog with adequate veterinary treatment within 24-hours. It must be noted that we attempted to contact the owner several times while at the property but this was unsuccessful.

Upon follow-up 1 January 2026, we met with the owner and obtained the following information:
The dog was taken to AACL on 24 December 2025 and given medication. The abscess ruptured 4 days after it had been at the veterinarian.

The owner said she is taking the dog back to AACL on 2 January 2026. We issued a Notice to Comply to the owner - cautioning her that should she fail to take the dog back for veterinary treatment, further action may be taken against her.

Upon follow-up 2 January 2026:

The owner informed us that she took the dog for the follow-up earlier the day.
We contacted AACL on the same day and they sent us proof that the owner was there .

As stated in previous email, we will conduct a final inspection in 2 weeks.
