At this moment dog fighting is an epidemic in my community. I have rescued 1 animal from these children. The other one is still at the location as listed above.

The ring leaders as I have come to know are:

Baker & Micky (brothers)

and a boy named Lukey.

When members of the community confiscate the dogs and nurse them to health, they come and threaten them and remove the dogs, fight them again and return the dogs worse off.

Baker is currently in hospital as a member of the community broke his arm after he was assaulted by a community member after making a pitbull aggressive and then cornering the cat and watching the pitbull kill the cat and laughing.

I honestly am tired of reporting and it not being a matter of urgency. These animals are being bitten and hurt for no reason.

This can not be beaten with a haphazard or long winded approach. U will need to get multiple vans/inspectors to hit multiple properties at the same time as if its done any other way they will warn each other. Members of the community will be able to provide a map to Lukeys house as he is the worst and most brutal of the lot and can be seen with a different, injured pitbull every second day.

The fights used to take place late on Friday and Saturday nights but now they take place in the day too.

If you would like to contact me for further information please do so via email. Currently a community member at the above address has a dog which they have rescued from them (they have saved this dog before) and Mickey is harassing them to give the dog back and the previous time Lukey showed up, threatened them and took the dog.

Please let this not be a case where these kids have no repercussions for their actions as they are renowned for being a law on to their own and being violent towards community members.
