Good day

We have a situation at our estate with dogs that are left outside and constantly barking and crying .
The security has warned the owners about the dogs already who appear to be neglected.
The poor dogs are locked out..and all curled up on a chair each.
The owner gets home past 2am or 3am and they cry whole day and night.
During the day the owners go to work and the 2 small dogs are outside with no access into the unit.
We don't see fresh water and food either. The garden is suitable for dogs who are left outside - no real
grass , not sufficient shade, no covered shelter for the dogs.
The garden can get very hot and shade is gone in the afternoon.
During the day they bark excessively wanting to get into the unit, so they howl and cry all day long
It's become emotionally disturbing for the residents aswell.
The owners are ignoring the warnings from security.

We ask that the SPCA kindly inspect and speak to the owners of the dogs .
