Thank you for taking our call and for discussing the matter.

The collection has been scheduled for [06/01/2026].

Unfortunately, we cannot commit to an exact time due to the nature of our operations. Our aim is to always attend to animal collections as speedily as possible. However, this is not always possible due to the number of emergency cases we receive – emergency cases always take priority. Please also take note of the following:

1. Once surrendered, the owner has no further rights to the animals and the SPCA is then given full rights to decide on their future.
 2. The SPCA does not provide any updates on these surrendered animals to their previous owners after they have been surrendered.
 3. The SPCA unfortunately cannot guarantee that an animal will be put up for adoption after surrender and can make no promises in that regard.
- The above are unfortunately in place due to the fact that we take in up to 24000 stray and surrendered animals per year, which is a near impossible task. There are simply not enough good homes out there for all these animals.

this is an extremely urgent situation. These symptoms could indicate a serious trauma, a severe allergic reaction, a neurological issue, or a major infection. Time is absolutely critical for his comfort and chance of survival.

Your two fastest options for help are:

1. Take him to the nearest emergency veterinary clinic immediately. This is the best course of action. They have the staff and equipment to provide intensive care, pain relief, and a diagnosis at this time.
2. If an emergency vet is not accessible or feasible, bring him directly to the SPCA.
