STANDARD CONDITIONS

1. When the holder of this permit *kills/captures/collect any wild animal in terms thereof, he shall, before leaving the abovementioned property, or if he does not leave it, after each day's hunt/capture/collection, record the particulars regarding the date, species and number of each sex of each species, or if it is impossible to distinguish the sex, the total number of each species of such wild animals which he had *killed/capture/collected.
2. The holder of this permit shall return it to the Chief Executive Officer : Western Cape Nature Conservation Board, Private Bag X29, Gatesville, 7766, within 14 days of the date of expiry thereof.
3. THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO THE SPECIAL CONDITIONS AS SET OUT IN THE ADDENDUM HERETO.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

This permit will come into effect upon expiry of permit CN43-87-30195 on 15/08/2025.

1. This permit is issued for the purposes of conducting bird abatement services (the deterrent and/or population management/reduction of nuisance or damage-causing birds) in the Western Cape Province ONLY.
2. The hunting methods authorized with this permit are to hunt:
 - (a) with the aid of artificial light
 - (b) during the period one hour after sunset on any day and one hour before sunrise on the following day
 - (c) by means of any weapon in a public place within the area of jurisdiction of a local authority.
- 2.1. The prohibited hunting methods authorised with this permit for Egyptian geese (*Alopochen aegyptiaca*) are:
 - (a) the capturing in trap cages and
 - (b) the humane destruction of captured wild birds which you apply for with an air rifle ONLY.
- 2.2. This permit does not authorise the shooting of wild birds outside of a trap cage or outside of the direct, physical control of the hunter i.e., the shooting of Egyptian geese "on the wing" or free- roaming Egyptian geese with an air rifle on the ground is NOT permitted.
3. This permit to hunt wild animals by means of prohibited hunting methods for conducting bird abatement services does not authorise the permit holder or additional hunters to conduct any other activity (inter alia this permit does not authorise the transport, sale, donation or captivity of wild animals).
4. The bag limits per day, per site for each species listed on this permit are:
 - i) 40 x speckled pigeon (*Columba guinea*)
 - ii) unlimited x house sparrow (*Passer domesticus*)
 - iii) unlimited x feral pigeon (*Columba livia domestica*)
 - iv) unlimited x rock pigeon (*Columba livia*)
 - v) unlimited x Egyptian Geese (*Alopochen aegyptiaca*)
 - vi) unlimited x Common Myna (*Acridotheres tristis*)
 - vii) unlimited x Starlings (*Sturnidae*)
5. Only the species and quantities as per special condition number 4 may be hunted.
6. The disposal of carcasses must be done in accordance with the National Environmental Management: Waste Act and all other applicable municipal bylaws relating to waste management.
7. This permit is subject to all relevant sections of any legislation governing the use of firearms. The issuance of this permit does not give permission to the permit holder or hunters to discharge a firearm (as defined in the Firearms Control Act 60 of 2000) in a municipal area, public place or built-up area.
8. The permit holder must assess and address any risks, impacts and implications posed by the deterrent and/or population management/reduction of nuisance or damage-causing speckled pigeon (*Columba guinea*) to indigenous biodiversity prior to any capture and killing activities being carried out under this permit so as to avoid, minimize and mitigate any risks posed to indigenous biodiversity and to ensure that conservation best practice and a holistic approach to nuisance and/or damage causing bird management is achieved.
9. Should any enquiries or complaints be received from the general public about any population management / control of nuisance or damage causing birds under this permit by the permit holder and/or the authorised additional hunters, the onus is on the permit holder (service provider) and/or landowner (client) to explain / inform the member(s) of the general public of the management / control programme.
10. A register must be kept by the permit holder to record the outcomes of all hunts ; this register must include the date of each hunt, the location of each hunt (physical address and GPS location) and the species and quantity of individuals hunted. This register must be submitted to CapeNature upon the application for a renewal of this permit.
11. Upon renewal of this permit, the permit holder must submit landowner's written permission/s containing 1) the full name and surname of the landowner; 2) the full name and surname of the hunter; 3) the number and species of wild animal; 4) the date or dates and 5) the property name and number as it appears on the title deed in respect of which the permission is being granted. The permission document must be in the hunter's possession prior to the hunt taking place and / or a wild animal carcass or part thereof is removed from the property.

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12. This permit also authorizes the following people to act as additional hunters subject to the same standard and special permit conditions listed in this permit:

13. This prohibited hunting method permit for conducting bird abatement services has an expiry date and the onus is on the permit holder to apply for the renewal of this permit, if applicable, at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration.

14. Failure to comply with the regulatory framework or any of the conditions upon which this permit was issued will result in further legal action by CapeNature (which may include the suspension or revocation of the permit and the exclusion of the permit holder and/or additional hunters, either for a determined exclusion period or permanently, from qualifying for a subsequent permit to conduct any activity involving a raptor in the Western Cape Province).
