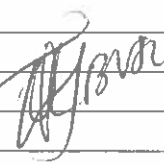
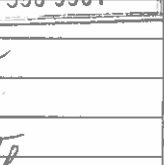
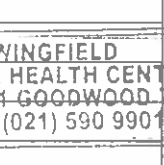

2026/01/13 W = 28.8 kg	Presented with red swelling on (R) elbow, draining tract present, slightly firm. Suspected abscess. Vera still walking normally. Cleaned & applied Silbecor. Amoxycillin (375mg): 1 1/2 tab twice a day for 7 days. Ondansetron (40mg): 1 tab once a day for 7 days. Apply Silbecor 1-2 x a day. Rest for the rest of the week. Follow up again on Tuesday (20/01/2026). Please return asap if any signs of sudden lameness, changes in appetite/behaviour or if wound/opening enlarges. Clean with clean water if dirty. 10/02/2026	Infection cleared, no draining tract/hole present, but still a firm swelling, not hot to touch / not painful upon palpation. Surface still slightly ulcerated, handler reports better response to Silbecor. Discontinue Silbecor - apply daily as needed. Hesitant to perform surgery, dog here on deployment. If dog comfortable, recommend taking Vera to local vet at home unit after deployment. Please return asap if Vera in pain, swelling infected or any other abnormalities.
