Subject: Animal Welfare Concern and Possible Neglect – Mitchell's Plain

Dear SPCA Inspectorate,

I would like to report concerns regarding the welfare of dogs kept at 10 Rooikat Close, Eastridge, Mitchell's Plain.

Multiple dogs, including a large husky, are continuously left outside unattended and appear inadequately supervised. Neighbours have repeatedly had to provide food and water to the animals. The dogs roam freely in the cul-de-sac and are never kept on leashes or properly contained.

There has been an incident where a small dog became trapped in the gate due to an obstruction placed by the owner and had to be assisted by a resident. The dogs have also attempted to attack neighbouring cats, creating safety concerns for residents.

Large amounts of dog faeces are left uncleaned in the road and surrounding properties, resulting in a significant fly infestation and unsanitary living conditions.

The matter has been raised directly with the occupants, but the situation continues. They have even told us that we can report them to the SPCA if we have a problem. I kindly request that an inspector investigate the welfare and living conditions of the animals.
