I am currently renting two doors down from a person who has been mistreating their dog over the course of the four months I have lived here.

It sounds as though the dog is currently left outside on the premises alone at the back frequently. Often heard whimpering and howling and have also heard multiple episodes when the owner has come to take out their anger on the dog, heard crying and whimpering before proceeding with a beating. This is cowardly and disgusting behaviour. I do not think the dog is getting any kind of humane treatment based on what can be heard.
