Dear SPCA Team,

I hope you are well.

I am writing to request a welfare check on three dogs. I currently reside on the property and would like to request that my identity remain confidential, as I am concerned about possible tension within the household if it becomes known that I raised these concerns.

I am worried about the general care and wellbeing of the dogs. They are rarely taken for walks and are typically only walked when they begin digging holes or acting out. There is no grass in the yard, and their bedding is torn and visibly dirty.

Their water is often green and does not appear to be refreshed regularly, despite this being raised with

the owners. Additionally, two of the three dogs appear noticeably underweight, with visible slimness that has caused concern.

I am not trying to cause conflict, but I genuinely care about the dogs' wellbeing and would deeply appreciate it if someone could assess the situation to ensure their basic needs are being met.
