You are hereby warned that:

1. No person shall use or cause to be used any animal for the purpose of safeguarding of which he is the owner or has the lawful custody, unless such person is the holder of a valid licence in terms of the Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935, as amended in 2016.

Please refer to Section 1 of the Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935:

1. Restriction on exhibition and training of performing animals and use of animals for safeguarding.—No person shall exhibit or train or cause or permit to be exhibited or trained for exhibition any animal of which he is the owner or has the lawful custody or use any animal for safeguarding unless such person is the holder of a licence.
[S. 1 substituted by s. 1 of Act No. 7 of 1991.]

- a. Should you not be in possession of a valid Performing Animals Protection Act Licence then you are not permitted to use any animal for safeguarding and must forthwith cease to use any such animal for safeguarding to avoid further action and/or criminal prosecution.
- b. Kindly forward a copy of your valid Performing Animals Protection Act Licence **within 24 hours** to our office by email to inspmanager@sPCA-ct.co.za

2. The environment where the animal is kept and working is extremely dirty and littered with filth. Further to this, there is several harmful objects that could possibly cause unnecessary injury to the dog. We here by warn you to clean the area of all rubble **by 18 March 2026, 15h00 (3pm)** or remove the dog from the premises with immediate effect, to avoid further action and/ or criminal prosecution.

Please refer to Section 2(1)(e) of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962:

(e) being the owner of any animal, deliberately or negligently keeps such animal in a dirty or parasitic condition or allows it to become infested with external

Please refer to Section 4(b)(i)(ii) of the Performing Animals Protection Act 4 of 2016

- (b) be kept in well maintained, hygienic and appropriate accommodation with:
- (i) an approved site plan for the primary and secondary facilities;
 - (ii) fencing and access control;

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and/or Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
