AFFIDAVIT

I, the undersigned

**RUDOLPH PIETER PHILANDER
(ID 9104085200088)**

Do hereby make oath in English and state that:

1. I am an adult male Inspector employed as such by the Cape of Good Hope Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals ("SPCA"), with business address situated at the corner of 1st Avenue and First Road, Grassy Park. My contact telephone number is 083 326 1618 and my email address is insp12@spca-ct.co.za
2. The facts contained in this affidavit fall within my personal knowledge, unless the context indicates otherwise, and are, to the best of my knowledge and belief, both true and correct.
3. On 30 January 2026, the Cape of Good Hope SPCA received a complaint together with supporting video footage depicting a white Chevrolet bakkie, with no canopy, pulling up next to a field in Kimberley Street, Goodwood.
4. I viewed the video footage and observed an unidentified adult Black male exiting from the passenger side of the vehicle. There was a different person driving the vehicle. The male walked to the left rear side of the bakkie, scratched around in the load bed and removed three kittens, one by one, placing them on the road next to the vehicle.
5. The male then re-entered the vehicle. As the vehicle drove off, it drove over one of the kittens and continued driving. The remaining two kittens were left on the roadway.
6. Later the same day, the SPCA received an image from Mr Dean Brian Bruyns showing the bakkie parked in the driveway of 118 Kimberley Street, Goodwood. The registration number of the bakkie was visible as CAA 127-722. Mr Bruyns provided me with an affidavit, attached hereto marked "A3".
7. On the same day, I received information that an adult female, Miss Cornelissen, residing at 54 Kimberley Way, Goodwood, was the person who had shared the CCTV footage. Her contact number was provided to me and I contacted her immediately.
8. During our conversation, Miss Cornelissen informed me that the incident occurred opposite her residence. She stated that she uplifted the two live kittens from the road. She further informed me that the kitten which had been driven over had died and that she uplifted the carcass as well.
9. Miss Cornelissen further stated that she transported the two live kittens to her aunt in Goodwood for safekeeping. Photographic evidence of the kittens uplifted from the roadway is attached hereto. Miss Cornelissen provided me with an affidavit, attached hereto marked "A2".
10. On the same day, I attended at Miss Cornelissen's residence to collect the carcass of the deceased kitten. The carcass was handed to me in a white plastic bag, which I placed in my official vehicle.

I, Rudolph Pieter Philander, further state under oath and in English that:

11. I thereafter proceeded to 118 Kimberley Street, Goodwood, being the address where the bakkie was seen. Upon arrival, I spoke to Mr Ridah Adam, who informed me that the vehicle belonged to his father-in-law, Mr Fadiel Isaacs.
12. Mr Adam informed me that the driver of the vehicle was Mr Shuaid Bosman and that the passenger who placed the kittens on the road was a worker employed by Mr Bosman, known to him only as "Rasta". Mr Adam provided me with Mr Isaacs' contact details.
13. I thereafter transported the carcass of the kitten to the SPCA, where it was stored pending a post-mortem examination.
14. On 2 February 2026, I transported the carcass to Ou-Kaapse Veterinary Clinic in Tokai, where a post-mortem examination was conducted by Dr Colin Martin. His findings and report are attached hereto marked "A5".
15. On the same day, I contacted Mr Fadiel Isaacs, who confirmed that he was not driving the vehicle at the time of the incident. He provided me with the contact details and address of Mr Shuaid Bosman. Mr Isaacs provided me with an affidavit, attached hereto marked "A4".
16. On 3 February 2026, I collected the remaining two kittens from Mr and Mrs Richard and Heliana, residing at 16 Frangipani Street, Tygerdal. I was able to positively identify the two kittens as the same kittens that had been dumped in Kimberley Street and uplifted by Miss Cornelissen. The kittens were thereafter admitted into the care of the SPCA.
17. On 5 February 2026, I collected the original affidavits from Miss Cornelissen and Mr Isaacs. The original CCTV footage was downloaded onto my memory stick by Miss Cornelissen and submitted as an exhibit under SAPS 13 reference number _____/2026.
18. In light of the evidence gathered, including witness statements, veterinary findings, and post-mortem results, I respectfully request that criminal charges be investigated against Mr Shuaid Bosman and the individual known as "Rasta", who will be fully identified by Mr Bosman, for contraventions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, including but not limited to the following sections:

Section 2(1)(e) for failing to provide the kitten with adequate veterinary treatment:

(e) being the owner of any animal, deliberately or negligently keeps such animal in a dirty or parasitic condition or allows it to become infected with external parasites or fails to render or procure veterinary or other medical treatment or attention which he is able to render or procure for any such animal in need of such treatment or attention, whether through disease, injury, delivery of young or any other cause, or fails to destroy or cause to be destroyed any such animal which is so seriously injured or diseased or in such a physical condition that to prolong its life would be cruel and would cause such animal unnecessary suffering;

Section 2(1)(p) for abandoning the cats

(p) being the owner of any animal, deliberately or without reasonable cause or excuse, abandons it, whether permanently or not, in circumstances likely to cause that animal unnecessary suffering;

I, Rudolph Pieter Philander, further state under oath and in English that:

Section 2(1)(q)

(q) causes, procures or assists in the commission or omission of any of the aforesaid acts or, being the owner of any animal, permits the commission or omission of any such act;

Section 2(1)(r)

(r) by wantonly or unreasonably or negligently doing or omitting to do any act or causing or procuring the commission or omission of any act, causes any unnecessary suffering to any animal; or

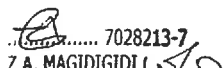

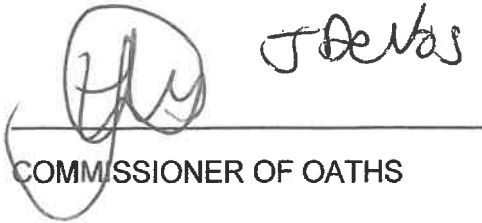
1. I am an adult male with identity number 7706065253085, residing at 48 Joubert Street. I am contactable on 084 564 3753.
2. The facts contained in this affidavit fall within my personal knowledge and are, to the best of my knowledge and belief, both true and correct.
3. On 30 January 2026, I became aware of an incident involving the abandonment of three kittens that occurred in Kimberley Street, Goodwood.
4. I viewed video footage of the incident, in which I observed an adult Black male passenger exiting a white Chevrolet single cab bakkie. I observed the male remove three kittens from the back of the bakkie, place them on the ground next to the roadway, and thereafter drive off in the vehicle
5. Later that same day, while driving in Kimberley Street, Goodwood, I observed a vehicle matching the description of the vehicle seen in the video footage. The vehicle in question is described as a white Chevrolet bakkie with registration number CAA 127-722
6. I stopped my vehicle and approached the occupants of the bakkie. Upon questioning them regarding the incident, the occupants admitted that they had dropped the kittens off.
7. I thereafter reported the matter to the Cape of Good Hope SPCA for further investigation.
8. I know and understand the content of this declaration.

I am an adult female who resides at 54 Kimberley street, Goodwood, Cape Town. My contact number is 0812345136. The facts contained in this affidavit fall within my personal knowledge unless indicated otherwise or unless it appears so from the context. The facts are also, to the best of my knowledge and belief, both true and correct.

2.

On 30 January 2026, I shared CCTV footage with the CoGH SPCA showing a white Chevrolet bakkie that had stopped opposite my house. I observed a black adult male getting out of the passenger side and take 3 kittens out of the back and placing them in the road. The adult male then got back into the vehicle. As the vehicle had driven off, one of the kittens was driven over. I went to the scene and saw that the kitten that was driven over had passed away. I uplifted the kittens, including the carcass of the one that died. I then transported the two kittens that was alive to my aunt's house, 16 Frangipani street, Tygerdal, Cape Town, for safety reasons.

2.1.

Later the afternoon, Inspector Rudolph Philander of the CoGH SPCA collected the carcass from me, at my residents, at around 18h00. I placed it in a white plastic bag and gave it to him. The incident was traumatizing and horrible. The poor kitten that was driven over did not deserve to die like that and none of them deserved to be dumped. This was very wrong.

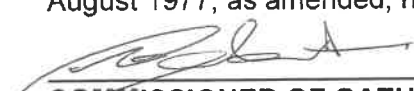
On 5 February 2026, Inspector Philander came to my property to obtain the original footage, of the incident and my affidavit that explained account of events.

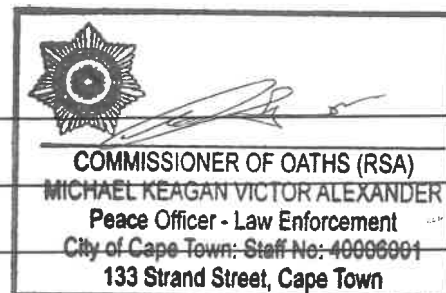

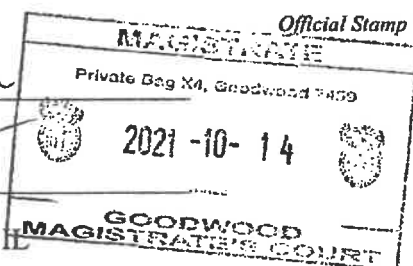

CHARGES IN TERMS OF THE ANIMALS PROTECTION ACT NO 71 OF 1962

The Cape of Good Hope Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) request that the accused be charged for animal cruelty in terms of the following Sections of the **Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962**:

SECTION 2

Offences in respect of animals - (1) Any person who:

(e) being the owner of any animal, deliberately or negligently keeps such animal in a dirty or parasitic condition or allows it to become infected with external parasites or fails to render or procure veterinary or other medical treatment or attention which he is able to render or procure for any such animal in need of such treatment or attention, whether through disease, injury, delivery of young or any other cause, or fails to destroy or cause to be destroyed any such animal which is so seriously injured or diseased or in such a physical condition that to prolong its life would be cruel and would cause such animal unnecessary suffering; or

- The accused allegedly abandoned the kittens and drove over one of the kittens, thereafter leaving it in the roadway without rendering assistance, resulting in catastrophic injuries.

(p) being the owner of any animal, deliberately or without reasonable cause or excuse, abandons it, whether permanently or not in circumstances likely to cause that animal unnecessary suffering;

- The accused were observed on CCTV footage wilfully abandoning three kittens in Kimberly Street, Goodwood

(q) causes, procures or assists in the commission or omission of any of the aforesaid acts or, being the owner of any animal, permits the commission or omission of any such act;

(r) by wantonly or unreasonably or negligently doing or omitting to do any act or causing or procuring the commission or omission of any act, causes any unnecessary suffering to any animal;

shall, subject to the provisions of this Act and any other law, be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine or imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve months or to such imprisonment without the option of a fine.

(2) For the purposes of sub-section (1) the owner of any animal shall be deemed to have permitted or procured the commission or omission of any act in relation to that animal if by the exercise of reasonable care and supervision in respect of that animal he could have prevented the commission or omission of such act.

(3) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any law, a magistrate's court shall have jurisdiction to impose any penalty provided for in this section.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS IN TERMS OF THE CONSTITUTION

(SECTION 35 OF ACT NO. 108 OF 1996)

You are being detained for the following reason:

CONTRAVENTION OF THE
ARREST PROTECTION ACT 55 OF 1997

As a person who is detained you have the following rights:

- (a) you have the right to consult with a legal practitioner of your choice or, should you so prefer, to apply to the Legal Aid Board to be provided by the State with the services of a legal practitioner;
- (b) you have the right to challenge the lawfulness of your detention in person before a court of law and to be released if such detention is unlawful;
- (c) you have the right to be detained under conditions consonant with human dignity, which shall include at least the provision of adequate accommodation, nutrition, reading material and medical treatment at state expense; and
- (d) you have the right to be given the opportunity to communicate with, and be visited by, your spouse or partner, next-of-kin, religious counsellor and a medical practitioner of your choice.

As a person arrested for the alleged commission of an offence, you have the following rights:

- (a) you have the right to remain silent and anything you say may be recorded and may be used as evidence against you;
- (b) you are not compelled to make a confession or admission which could be used in evidence against you;
- (c) you have the right to be brought before a court as soon as reasonably possible but not later than 48 hours after your arrest or the end of the first court day after the expiry of the 48 hours, if the 48 hours expire outside ordinary court hours or on a day which is not an ordinary court day;
- (d) you have the right, at the first court appearance after your arrest, to be informed of the reason for your continued detention, or to be released; and
- (e) you have the right to be released from detention if the interests of justice permit, subject to reasonable conditions.

You can exercise all the abovementioned rights at any stage during your detention.

POST MORTEM VETERINARY REPORT

AFFIDAVIT

I, **Collin Armand Martin**, hereby make oath in English and declare as follows:

1. I am Collin Armand Martin, Identity Number 8205065266087. I am a 43-year-old adult male employed as a specialist anatomical veterinary pathologist at Idexx South Africa, where I have been employed since 2014.
2. I qualified as a veterinarian in 2008 at the Onderstepoort Faculty of Veterinary Science. I practised as a small animal clinician at Blue Hills Veterinary Clinic in Kyalami from 2009 to 2014. In 2014, I commenced an anatomical pathology residency with Idexx at Onderstepoort, during which time I received specialist training under, inter alia, Dr Liza du Plessis and Dr Sarah Clift. I obtained a Master of Veterinary Medicine (MMedVet) in Pathology in 2020.
3. I obtained the degree Master of Veterinary Medicine (MMedVet) in Anatomical Pathology in 2020. I am currently registered with the South African Veterinary Council as a specialist anatomical veterinary pathologist under registration number S020/06090 and am employed as a senior specialist anatomic veterinary pathologist for Idexx South Africa.
4. I am currently employed as a senior specialist anatomic veterinary pathologist at Idexx South Africa and am experienced in conducting post-mortem examinations and determining causes of death in animals.
5. I make this affidavit in terms of section 212(4) of the Criminal Procedure Act 51 of 1977, the contents whereof fall within my personal knowledge and expertise and are, to the best of my knowledge and belief, both true and correct.
6. Due to the unavailability of state post-mortem services, I was contacted by the Inspectorate of the Cape of Good Hope SPCA and requested to assist with a post-mortem examination in a suspected animal cruelty matter.
7. I performed the post-mortem examination at the Ou Kaapse Veterinary Clinic on the morning of 02 February 2026. The carcass was presented to me in a sealed bag bearing admission number A61526.

I, **Collin Armand Martin**, hereby make further oath in English and declare as follows:

8. POST-MORTEM FINDINGS

7.1 The carcass was that of a young, approximately four- to six-week-old, black and white male kitten in fair body condition.

7.2 External examination revealed severe crush injury to the head with marked deformation, as well as haemorrhage within and surrounding the oral cavity.

7.3 Upon reflection of the skin, the skull was found to be irregularly fractured with associated periosteal haemorrhage. The brain within the calvarium was liquefied.

7.4 Further examination of the head revealed multiple mandibular fractures.

7.5 Examination of the thoracic cavity revealed multifocal, irregular, well-demarcated dark red areas within the lungs, consistent with aspiration of blood.

7.6 No additional injuries or pathological changes were observed in the remaining organs.

9. PROFESSIONAL OPINION

8.1 Based on my training, knowledge, and experience, I conclude that the kitten died as a result of severe blunt force trauma to the head.

8.2 The injuries observed are consistent with trauma that may be sustained in a motor vehicle accident, particularly if the animal was run over by a tyre.

8.3 Death would have been instantaneous. Although there is no evidence to suggest prolonged suffering, the manner of death remains cruel and unlawful, particularly if inflicted intentionally.

8.4 Correlation with the surrounding circumstances of the death will be essential in determining intent.

10. CONCLUSIONS

9.1 Based on my examination of the carcass and having regard to my training, qualifications, and experience, I am of the opinion that the kitten died as a direct result of severe blunt force trauma to the head.

9.2 The nature, extent, and severity of the injuries are not consistent with natural causes and indicate the application of significant external force. The injuries observed are compatible with the kitten having been subjected to a high-impact traumatic event. Death would have occurred immediately or within moments of the infliction of the injuries.
