When they were small these two puppies stayed inside but now that they are bigger they have been left outside in a small cordoned off space; when I arrived the dogs did not have access to water (you can see containers filled with dirty water in the background) and their only source of shelter is a small piece of plastic that has been placed at a slant. The white male dog is larger than the female so he intimidates her which leaves her unable to get to the food or go under the plastic - she was shaking in a corner when I left.

The property is a big plot and is two properties away from number 1272 (property circled in the screenshot) and is an RDP house amongst various bungalows.
