We trust this email finds you well.

We have concluded this matter and final feedback follows:

Throughout the investigation, notices and warnings were issued requiring shelter, grooming, and veterinary care for the dog named Hunter. Subsequent inspections confirmed that the dog had been taken to a veterinarian, who diagnosed arthritis and laryngeal paralysis but stated his condition was manageable. Over the following weeks, inspectors noted that Hunter was kept indoors with proper shelter, water, and a clean environment, and his breathing had improved. At the final inspection on 13 February 2026, the inspector reported that Hunter was free roaming inside the house, had access to shelter and water, appeared in fair condition, and was breathing better. The case was therefore closed with no further action required.

We would like to thank you for reporting this matter to us and your care for animal welfare.
