This inspection was conducted on 08 June 2026 as part of the NSPCA community outreach in Bonnytown, Wetton Road, Wynberg, between 09:30 and 15:30. The property inspected was Stand B23, with the registered owner identified as Lindelwa Billy, contactable on 068 834 3802. A total of 5 animals were found on the property at the time of inspection, comprising 5 dogs and 0 cats. The following animals were recorded: 5 dogs: Patches (Dog - Mix, female, tan and white (green card Y G46505)); Puppy (Dog - Mix, male, tan and white); Pops (Dog - Mix, male, brindle and white); Katetjie (Dog - Mix, female, tan and white); Duke (Dog - Mix, male, tan). On the day of inspection, all animals were dewormed and tick and flea treatment was administered to all animals. The owner was educated on responsible pet ownership and general animal welfare. Sterilisation green card was issued on the day for the following animal: G46505 issued for Patches (Dog - Mix, female). A warning was issued regarding two dogs, Pops and Duke, who were found chained on the property. The owner was warned about chaining practices and educated on relevant animal welfare legislation. Rectification is required before the follow-up visit. A follow-up inspection has been scheduled for 11 June 2026. The owner is required to address all warnings noted above before this date.
