RELEASE AGREEMENT

I, Ammaarah Khwange, identified by Identity Number **9502020017089**, hereby acknowledge and affirm that I am the lawful owner of the animal/s seized by the SPCA pursuant to the provisions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 (together with Regulation 468) on 26 May 2026 from 5 Walker Crescent, Ext. 21 Belhar. The said animal/s are listed below and have since been admitted into the care of the SPCA under the respective Admission numbers:

In consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Conditions for Return of Animals

- a. The Owner acknowledges that the animals identified below will be returned to the Owner's care, subject to the following conditions:

Return Conditions:

- i. The Owner shall maintain their property in a clean and hygienic manner by at all times.
- ii. The animal shall be sterilised by the SPCA prior to release.
- iii. The Owner shall ensure that the animal is kept in conditions compliant with the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, particularly Section 2 and its subsections, including but not limited to:

iv. 2(1)(b) – the animal shall be free roaming at all times.

v. 2(1)(e) – the animal must be provided with adequate veterinary treatment at all times.

- b. The Owner consents to the SPCA sterilising the animal. I understand that sterilisation is a surgery to make my animal unable to produce offspring. I further confirm that I will not hold the SPCA or its officials liable for neutering my animal and or any complications resulting thereof, and I authorise the use of anaesthetics and other medications, as deemed necessary by the attending veterinarian.
- c. The Owner consents to the SPCA microchipping the animal for identification purposes.
- d. An Inspector of the SPCA shall be granted permission to inspect the animals at the Owner's premises at any reasonable time to ensure their welfare and compliance with the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962.
- e. That the owner shall not be afforded a second opportunity to ventilate this issue nor be entitled to any opportunity to negotiate the return of any animals should a second seizure become necessary, and shall, as a direct result thereof, be

charged criminally in the instance that an inspection conducted reveals any deviation from the above conditions.

2. Costs Incurred by SPCA with Seizure of Animal/s

2.1. In terms of section 5 of Regulations 468, I am responsible for:

- a. The reasonable expenses incurred in connection with the seizure of my animal, which include:
 - i. Expenses incurred by the SPCA for any veterinary or medical treatment rendered to the animal; and
 - ii. Expenses incurred by the SPCA for the transportation of the animal from the point of seizure to the SPCA; and
 - iii. Expenses incurred by the SPCA for accommodating (housing, caring and feeding) the animal.
- b. Paying these reasonable expenses, before the animal may be released to me, for such period up to and until the animal is released to me.

3.2. I undertake to pay to the SPCA the reasonable expenses pertaining to the said animal, as set out in paragraph 3.1. above, within 48 hours of the date hereof.

3.3. Should I fail to settle these expenses in full within 48 hours from the date of this claim, I forfeit the animal to the SPCA, for it to become the sole and beneficial owner thereof, and I consent to the SPCA disposing of the animal, as it deems fit, in order to recover these expenses, or part thereof (if any). If any funds are left, after such expenses have been defrayed from the proceeds of the sale of the animal/s, they are to be paid to me into an account nominated by me in writing for this purpose.

3.4. Neither the SPCA, nor any of its agents or employees, will, save for the obligation to make the payment to me (if any) in terms of paragraph 5.1, be held liable for any loss or damage that I may suffer as a result of the disposal of the animal

necessitated by my failure to settle the expenses mentioned hereinbefore, in full, within 7 days from the date of signing this document.

- 3.5. If applicable, I will also be liable for the payment of a fine for contravening certain sections of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962. Such a fine will be issued in terms of Section 56 of the Criminal Procedures Act 51 of 1977, as prescribed by the Chief Magistrate of the district.

4. Finality of SPCA's Decisions

The Owner acknowledges and agrees that should he/she fail to comply with anything provision in this agreement that any decision made by an officer of the SPCA regarding the welfare or disposition of the animal shall be final and binding.

5. Costs Associated with the Enforcement of this Agreement

The Owner agrees to bear all costs incurred in connection with the enforcement of this agreement, including but not limited to legal fees and veterinary expenses.

6. Criminal Offences

The Owner understands that offences under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 are criminal in nature. The SPCA reserves the right to prosecute or cause to be prosecuted any offence in relation to this contract, notwithstanding any other powers afforded to them by the Act. The Owner further understands that this matter may be referred to the criminal court should the Owner be suspected, on reasonable grounds, of having committed any offence in relation to the Act.
