Subject: Request for URGENT Inspectorate Assistance

I am writing to request the urgent and immediate intervention of your Inspectorate regarding ongoing animal welfare violations at 1 Fortuna Road, Sanddrift, Milnerton.

This is not a first-time offence. The property was reported to the SPCA and Law Enforcement in April, following which I understand the suspect was fined. To my knowledge, SPCA inspectors have attended the property on at least four occasions, yet the situation remains unchanged.

The current welfare concerns include:

- Dogs being kept on chains.
- Unsterilised dogs.
- The continued distribution of puppies.
- Unsafe and cruel living conditions.

In my previous report, an unsterilised mother dog and her puppies had escaped the premises. I have now been informed that this has happened again. It is deeply concerning that repeated intervention has failed to bring about any meaningful or lasting improvement for the animals involved.

Given the repeated nature of these violations, I respectfully request that this matter be treated with the utmost urgency and priority. I would also appreciate feedback regarding what further enforcement action will be taken to prevent this cycle from continuing.

If existing measures continue to prove ineffective, I would appreciate guidance on what avenues of escalation are available, as the ongoing welfare of these animals cannot continue to be compromised.
